

INCIDENT: Boise man arrested for Enticement of a Child over the Internet

WHEN: Thursday September 16 at about 10:00 am

PEOPLE INVOLVED: Ryan M. White, 26, Boise

DETAILS: Ada County Sheriff's detectives have arrested a Boise man who used the internet to entice a teenager to meet him for sex.

On Thursday, September 16, Ryan M. White, 26, of Boise, was arrested in connection with an on-going Ada County Sheriff's Office investigation. In recent months, White had been talking online with a detective posing as a 14-year-old teenage girl. White spoke about his intent to have sexual contact with the girl and discussed plans to meet at different places around Boise.

Based on those conversations, an arrest warrant was obtained for White on Wednesday, September 15. He was located and arrested by Sheriff's deputies today. White was later booked into the Ada County Jail on a felony charge of sexual enticement of a minor over the internet.

This arrest is the result of work by the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force. The Ada County Sheriff's Office receives ICAC grant money to help fund these investigations that are conducted on an on-going basis.
