The Post Falls Police Department, in collaboration with the Kootenai County Sherriff's Department, the Coeur d' Alene Police Department and the Idaho Attorney General's Office have develop a task force combating criminal activity against children using the Internet. The program named *Internet Crimes against Children (ICAC)*, includes investigators from each of the mentioned agencies.

As part of this task force, the participating agencies receive investigative leads from throughout the nation, notifying the task force of illegal Internet activity. These investigative leads involve criminal activity against children over the Internet.

The Post Falls Police Department has been involved in actively investigating one of these leads provided to us by the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC). The information received alleged that a local Post Falls resident was participating in the delivery of child pornography using the Internet.

After nearly two months of investigation, the Post Falls Police Department and the Idaho Attorney Generals Office served a search warrant at the Post Falls home of Kevin Greer, 52 years of age.

During the search of Mr. Greer's residence, the Police Department seized several computers from the residence and located evidence of illegal Internet activity. These computers will be forensically inspected for additional illegal information.

Additionally, investigators interviewed several young people who have disclosed that Mr. Greer committed sexual acts on them when they were younger, specifically in the 7-12 YOA range. These sexual acts allegedly went on for several years with all of the children interviewed.

Mr. Greer was arrested and taken to the Kootenai County Jail and booked on three felony charges of lewd conduct with a minor child under the age of 16, bond was set at \$500,000.00. This investigation is on going; as additional information becomes available we will provide follow up press releases.
